



GROWTH OF HOTSPOTS





SOA FOR PROVISION OF WI-FI SERVICES FOR GOVERNMENT BUREAUX AND DEPARTMENTS (B/DS)

Effective from 1 March 2019, Standing Offer Agreements are arranged for acquiring and installing the Wi-Fi Service for Internet access at B/Ds' venues

mobile Wi-Fi

For Optical Fiber: <=1Gbps per venue For Mobile Wi-Fi: > 20Mbps per access point Support dual frequency bands: 2.4GHz and 5GHz

SUBSIDY SCHEME FOR PROVIDING FREE PUBLIC WI-FI SERVICES

Launched in March 2017 Providing financial support for eligible non-profit-making organisations to offer the services in their study rooms and youth service centres

BENEFITS TO SOCIETY



More government premises with free Wi-Fi service installed, more convenient for the public to connect to the Internet



Tourists can use Wi-Fi service to share their photo or video taken at tourist attraction spots easily; and in turn promote the image of Hong Kong



Subsidy scheme facilitates the public (students in particular) to utilise and learn from Internet resource



Pilot project encourages subvented organisations to make use of technology products to improve services to public



PUBLIC-PRIVATE COLLABORATION AT GOVERNMENT VENUES

Public-private collaboration (PPC) approach has been adopted to provide free public Wi-Fi services at government venues since 2016.



No payment between the Government and the Service Provider (SP) The SP is allowed to operate value-added services at the venues to sustain the Wi-Fi operation

CONSULTATION AND INVITATIONS

Consulted the industry, positive views and support received Four rounds of PPC invitations conducted so far

Service Providers to provide free public Wi-Fi services at more than 100 government and public venues, e.g. public transport interchanges, footbridges, parks, toilets, land borders, museums, promenades, public hospitals etc. **60**

Venues with Wi-Fi Services and value-added services progressively launched since August 2017 Years Service Agreement with lead time (12- 18 months) for service installation



仲要我 入資料 政府近年大力推動免費公共 Wi-Fi服務・並着力提升公共Wi-Fi 服務的質素。為提升上網達度及穩定 性,超過九成的政府Wi-Fi場地定現开建綱給及IEE 802 11ac Wi-Fi標準。上網速度會相應提升至平均每秒20兆比 特(Mbps)或以上,較現時平均每秒3至4兆比特(Mbps)大幅 提高。

現時,部份戶外的政府場地缺乏固定網絡設施。若鎬設 網絡,需進行大量追點工程,既所費不非,亦需時較長,難 以在短期內有效地提供小厂服務,有見近年志動網絡技術 不斷發展,上網速度可遵至一定水平,政府早前在在款谷公 園、中裝涌公園和東浦比公園試行應用流動網絡技術,提供 全製WFTI服務。潮試試集團而,有關方案可以提供不錯的 連線速度,通常可達10%比特(Mbps)以上。
